I came across a strange Gemara (well I'm strange, I just had a hard time understanding it). The Gemara in Shabbos 89b asks why the pasuk ?? ???? ?????? ????? ????? refers to the crimson red sins in the plural form it should say ??? . The Gemara answers that if your aveiros are like these years ???? that are arranged in order from the begining of creation then Hashem will turn them white.

Now I read this over and over trying to make heads or tails of it with no success.

What does that mean?

I found that the Maharal in his chidushei aggados explains beautifully (though he doesnt need me approbation) He says there are people who sin occasionally and those people are certainly not affected by those aveiros. But then there are people who are so entrenched in their aveiros that its arranged and in order for what seems like forever. (we know that feeling all too well!) The pasuk is saying that even for these people who may think that their neshama has been soiled with indelible red ink, IT'S NOT TRUE !!!!
