Now, I am not saying that anyone needs to get clean for G-d's sake at all - but just that acting like you deserve His help because after all you are doing and trying sdo much for Him, is useless pretending and not the way to daven.

2- If you depend so much on these k'nasos, plans, and definitions - *it seems simple to me that you are really not depending on Him at all.* How do you know you are not just fully depending on these hishtadluyos to save you? If you are, then why in the world would He be inclined to do you a favor and spring you? That'd only bring you *farther* from Him, cuz you'd be even more sure of your power, then. So really, it may be that you are neither doing anything for His sake about this problem - only for yourself; and it may be that you are not even believing in His ability to help you - but just trusting that if only *you'd try hard enough* you can beat it...or *should* be able to, so you are not *depending* on Him. I think you completely missed the point I was trying to make, gyegye2, by just giving prepackaged answers to the questions. If you really were doing this out of a deep concern for kedushas habris or the Torah hak'dosha, then you would not be needing to tear up money to stop. Stopping so that you do not tear up or throw away money, is using pain to make you stopbecause Hashem and His Torah do not make you stop. You are just finding a selfish motivation that works. And you say you are doing it out of faith in Him and His love for you?

I believe what you wrote is 100% true: He does love you, gyegye2, no matter what you do, and there is nothing you can possibly do to make Hashem stop loving you and doing everything He can for your good. And also, I believe that the Torah hakedosha is kedai to suffer for, to tear up money for, whatever.

But none of those beliefs ever stopped me from using szex videos and having sex with myself as you are doing. I did those things anyway. And I assume you are, too.

But they are not the same, at all. Anyway, Kedusha is in you about your *heart*, not just about how clean your floor is.

People here have been posting to you things from the start because they saw your short-term tricks are *not* 'taking things one step at a time', but just *running for another day*. And it has not woirked well yet, has it?

If that's what you want, fine. But if - *if* - c"v you do *not* succeed, I hope you can have faith that Hashem really does want you to be His own and for you to be clean somehow - and that *He* sees your problem *not* as a *kedusha issue* at all, but as a mental and emotional illness that needs hard work and real, long term action - not just 'the daily trick' to be 'ggod'. We may be fooled to keep running into a brick wall, but Hashem is no fool.
