Here's my take:

Please guard over my eyes constantly from all forms of sights that would bring spiritual harm to my vision. Help me that I not gaze at anything that will bring me chas veshalom to improper thoughts. Lead my eyes away from seeing emptiness. On Your path let me live. Uncover my eyes for the purpose of seeing the wonders of your Torah.

The Yetzer Hora only has power over that which the eye sees. Sotah 8

When a person diverts his eyes from seeing bad if is an opportune time for the tefillos he davens then to be accepted (Shomer Emunim)

Getting pleasure from forbidden sights in this world causes one to lose the pleasure that will come from beholding the ziv hashechina in the world to come (Ben Yehoyada Brochos 61)

Otzem (closing) Eiynav (ones eyes) Mayraois (from seeing) Bi'ra (wicked) The last letters of the Hebrew spells out maos (money). To allude to the fact that guarding ones eyes is a segulah for parnasah

The desire for illicit relationships is only distanced from a person by a person distancing himself from forbidden sights and thoughts (sefer hamiddos)

The zohar states that when Reb Shimon Bar Yochai saw pretty woman "Al Tifno El Halilim" (zohar)

When a person walks down the street and guards his eyes he causes thoughts of teshuva to the entire street (said over from Eliezer Berlend)
