Its like someone who is drowning, if he kicks and tries to fight the current he will get tired and get sucked in further, but what is a person supposed to do instead, just stay calm and go with the flow or grab on to an object that can help keep him afloat if possible. and only when he reaches calmer waters can he swim to safety.

So I would say, STAY in the accountability group, and feel BAD about making us pay I know its hard to believe this when we are having a difficult time, which is when we go into panic mode and we try and fight the strong current of the Y'h, But what should we do? take a moment to realize I am drowning and I cant fight this current, which is something you should be feeling if you are struggling so hard and than step back, ride the wave, grab onto anything that floats your way at of course don't forget to call out to Hashem the chief coast guard to save you from this lust and take it from you. or if you want to at least try and tread water, grab onto any floatation device you can, read through the handbook or forum.
