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To Alex Eliezer it was my pleasure, I have spent a long time using K9 and am happy to help others use it properly.

At Jewish Jew, whether you have the ability to block Picasa etc will depend on the level of stringency that you want. I employ a method that blocks Google itself and therefore my Picasa is 95% blocked! To get round the Gmail problem I use Outlook which isnt browser dependent so it works fine. There are more aspects to K9 that people have to know, I have never met the filter
