He is not very religious: he celebrate the chagim, but he don't go to shul on shabbos, and he don't put tfilin if I don't offer to do so. I wonder how it will be possible to help him, if it will be possible... Of course, I can't speak about this clearly with this person, for questions of respect, and I think that talking clearly with him can do the things worse.

Maybe to sign up him discretly to the mails of 'Hizuk? Or something else?

Or I have to give up, and just pray and wait that one day he will begin to "open his eyes"?

And my wife can't also do this.
