I would love to hear you explain what you mean. How does someone not lust?

What I meant is something like this. There are two types of lust. One of them is the attraction that a normal healthy male has to most women. The other is one that's caused by the need to release some sort of tension.

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The first is something that we can't change. It's a plain and simple tayvah and we can control ourselves and not lust. The less we do it the easier it becomes.

The second one is what really causes us to fall. A lot of us use lust, porn and masturbation to self soothe. Very much the same way some people use food, movies, drugs, books, sleep, etc. to relieve the negative feelings they have.

The problem is that like many things we do, we don't realize what the real motivation for it is. So we get into a cycle of falling and trying to stop. We fall, feel bad, decide to stop, and then the stressors start building up until we fall. The problem is that since we thought we fell because we just couldn't control ourselves we try working on self control. Really we need to be working on the real causes.
