Similar those of us who have been to dark websites, apps, places etc. and then work on stopping have brought the netzios out from really dark places. This is the avodah of the generations before moshiach... bringing Hashem to the lowest of the lows and bringing up the netzios from the farthest things from kedusha. This is not easy work and sometimes we slip, but as long as we are in the fight we are doing our generation's work. Instead of feeling shame and down about our thoughts and the things we done, be proud we are doing our part to bring moshiach closer.
