First of all I'd like to explain why I probably fell. I am pretty it is stress related and I was trying to escapoe the pressures of the stress. 2) I needed to really understand what it meant that our lives are "unmanageable". When I went through this step, I didnt hesitate to answer yes, I fully believed it, and I even preached it. But I didnt really understand what that meant. For the first time in my life I teared because I fell. Right afterwards. I am not a very emotional person so when I tear somethings gotta give. My life is completely unmanageable like this. I need Hashem to control me, I cant control me.
