Eme, you are doing the right steps, but what is the most impressive about you, is that when you fall, you LEARN from the fall and try NEW and BETTER approaches. It's being Misgaber each time anew that brings a person to true Deveikis with Hashem. (See the Maharal Netiv Coach Hayetzer Park 4)

Vow to yourself that you won't give up this battle until you win, no matter what and no matter how many times you fall. You may say, "but if i keep falling even AFTER I've taken so many steps, what's the use?". Let me reveal to you a secret. There are methods that can save ANYONE, no matter what they have been through. There are things we haven't even mentioned

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on the website, because they are only for those who are SO determined, that they've tried everything and despite nothing helping, they continue to make the effort to seek out further help. This only happens when a person truly feels this is a fight for his LIFE, and he feels he is losing everything by these behaviors - this world and the next.
