I am going to in-person SA meetings in the Cleveland area. I have the following minor objections:

1. I had to get a sponsor who is not a Torah Jew. I am the only frum person there. He speaks to me about what G-d wants me and it is creepy. There are enough of us who need this that we don't need goyim there.

2. This is not a disease. This is like Hashem taking choice away from Paro. In twelve-step they talk about "figuring out G-d's will for us". We know what it is: the Torah. It's the same for all of us.

3. I believe that the proper Torah approach ought to include a time-limited neder to "do teshuva as soon as possible after lusting," (including the wife.) I have personal experience and good luck with that. Now I am struggling to recover, but the neder got me sober. I was sober for five years, and today sobriety is not a problem, resentment and rage are.

4. People need to accept that this is a sin. This is not so clear in 12-step.

I am still going to 12-step meetings because the group of other people like myself enables me to get out of myself and discover my triggers etc. but I wish we had a program more optimized to Torah Jews.
