- C. To encourage women both who are struggling or who are trying to help their spouses in their own struggles


It is my fervent hope that a Kiddush Shem Shamayim will come from this thread.

Dear Chashuve family,
From a Kabbala perspective, Tisha Ba'av meant that the unification of Hashem's 'masculine" property (Kishda Borich Hu) and his feminine property (Shechintai) was separated. This separation was caused by our sins.

As a result, the Shechina is in golus away from her "huband".

I look at Tu Ba'av as a tremendous Malitz Yosher and Tikun for the separation of Tisha B'aav. Even those women who apparently had no virtue for being married, told their perspective husbands to marry "L'shaim Shomayim".

Thus, we are telling Hakodosh Baruch Hu, even if we do Avairos, still bring back the Yichud between Kishda Borich Hu and Shechintai, which will result in Moshiach - just like we are marrying women who might not posses the virtues we are looking for.
