in other words we can say the problem with our brain and heart is, the ideas of Torahwhich are in our brain is compared to light, it SEES things as they are, the heart however is darkness, i dont mean evil, but i mean it does not see things as they REALLY are, the job is to bring the light from the Torah and Neshama, that see things as they TRULY are, and get the message to the heart so the heart also see things correctly, and as mentioned before, learning musar, brings the light of the Torah to the darkness of the heart and enlightens it also.

yanky approaches shimon and says ,why did you look at that lady,doesnt reuvan know that its forbidden?shimon will look at yanky and ask what does reuvans knowledge have to do with me?

what if yanky asks shimon, ,"how can you claim that you dont know about looking at women, reuvan has been shouting it in your ears?

shimon pulls out to expensive looking earplugs and says when shimon was talking to me , i had these in my ears!

we understand why shimon didnt hear ,dont we?

well the same thing is happening when our head tells our heart something, our heart is wearing earplugs, its called timtum halev, and what learning musar is doing is its BLASTING rays at the timtum and making cracks appear in the timtum, until small rays of light get through the cracks and shine some light into the recesses of the darkness thats in the heart, and makes a change.
