I feel angry because someone remove me, a friend I have in the past here.

He think (someone I do not know) that I be bad influence on my young friend and he advised my friend to continue not talking to me.

I never do any harm to young!

He be for me like my little brother. He help me more than I ever thought, yet he much younger.

For this, I give up and wanting to leave GYE, and I do what I want. Yes, I find the very things for which I blame lifetime.

It took more than 15 years acting and I feel tired of trying to overcome this.

I feel like I will never be unsuccessful in anything in life since I have six, seven years.

I shouldn't have really made a comparison. Also I wasn't talking about "big ?????". I was just talking generally about my rebbeim in Yeshiva and I really don't have anything to the gauge their emunah by. It's probably not helping my recovery to take the spiritual inventories of my Rebbeim. Since it's already been brought up though, it seems to me that we usually measured the emunah of our Rebbeim by their willingness to forgo material pursuits with the reliance that Hashem would provide for them, their outward fervor in Torah and mitzvos, or in other similar ways. I don't think I really had an opportunity to see their emunah expressed in every day or personal matters. What I have seen in the rooms of AA, by way of example, was a woman who shared that she had been complaining about her serious medical issues. In the meeting she came to realize that her complaints resulted from her lack of acceptance of God's will for her and her trust in Him. So that's all nice in theory, but She became emotional and cried over the fact that she hadn't fully accepted God's will for her. She seemed sincerely distraught over the simple fact that she created a distance between herself and Hashem. (I have seen her at many meetings and she doesn't get emotional over other issues.)

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
