Not that long ago i was also being pulled very strongly in opposite directions. For me, starting daf yomi and becoming committed to it laid the groundwork that i needed to clarify which direction i really wanted to go. I am not suggesting that you start daf yom at this point. However, if you can find something to commit to through the summer, that can help keep you grounded and focused no matter what else happens. A small honest and personal tefila every day can also help. Hashem knows all of your struggles and his love for you does not change no matter how many times you fall (many sources for this). Also, any pain that you had to go through, no matter how hard it is to understand, will ultimately be for your benefit. Keep this in mind when you daven and you can tell hashem that you have a hard time with that.
