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The Steipler z"l in his sefer Kereina D'igrasa Vol 1 has a section of amazing chizzuk on the topic of Kedusha...

Here are some points that are very important to internalize

? Even if you fall often, don't underestimate the tremendous zechus of each success. If one succeeds in overcoming his burning desire, the amount of holiness that he brings upon himself and the spiritual words is tremendous, like Yosef Hatzadik. It also repairs much of the spiritual damage caused by previous falls. Over time, he'll be able to undo all the spiritual damage he has caused (1:106, 1:107).

? The main tikun is learning Torah, especially when you aren't enjoying it (e.g. doing chazara, or pushing yourself to learn very deeply), and you are only learning because it's a mitzvah. Bottom line: If you toil in learning, you'll certainly have a complete tikun. (1:106)

? When your desire is burning, think about the tremendous zechus you'll get by overcoming it. (1:106)
