His answer was slightly different that those who say that the 12 Steps are compatible with Torah. He asked me, "Where do you think Bill took it from? They don't have the *chomer* (raw material) for such a program. How did he come up with it? Bill took it from us!

"If I would have the time, I would be able to show you **every line** in the book where they took it from." (I was thinking: Wow! It takes a major Talmid chochom to be able to make such a statement!)
