Someone quoted to me the **Mashgiach, Harav Moshe Wolfson Shlita**, who said to him in reference to GYE, "*minay u'bay shadeey bay narga*".

Shadi Bai Narga is a term the Gemara uses for a victorious argument or attack on a position literally it means "To throw in it a hatchet. I imagine the Mashgiach meant menai ubay, meaning either through our methods or their methods i.e. 12 steps, either way Shadi Bai Narga we are defeating or attacking the problem. (the Gemara's are in Sanhedrin 30b, also in Succah and Rosh Hashana).

But now that I see ZS's understanding I think he might be more correct on the menay ubay part.
