In other words I think she knows about my addiction but thinks it is much more moderate that what it really is, as in perhaps maybe 10% aware.

Anyways, I just explained to her that I think every household should have one so that our babysitter for example (my kids are too young to use a computer so I had to use the babysitter excuse) doesn't come across unwanted photos if she want to perform a google search or something of the kind.

Her reaction to that was "oh yes, of course thats just as important" which she said in a really understanding manner, which really felt good because I was a little bit worried that she would have trouble understanding why we need a filter at all and start complaining that she hopes I'm not back to my "dark habits". But G-D bless her soul, she obviously knew that I was really embarrassed and just went along with it. I know when the time is right, I'll be able to sit down and talk to her about everything, but right now I need to just focus on cleaning up my act.

As for the SA meetings, I haven't been to one yet, but am hoping to join one sometime this week. I will let you know how it goes.
