Come on guys. Tefillas rabim tamid nishmah!!

Today, Tuesday, 5th of teves, we will beezras Hashem recite perek 68-For the Conductor (yup. again.)

Another perek about the impending geula, but as we all know, every perek and pasuk has its own message.

I found one such message in the malbim.

So sweet. So beautiful. So fitting.

Okay.

So as we all know, we at GYE have a big part in bringing Moshiach.

The following words appear in persukim gimel and daled:

"As smoke is dispersed, please disperse them (our enemies)..... And the righteous will be glad....."
So we gotta know this stuff

The Malbim says the following... (if I didn't see this myself, I would have a hard time believing it)...

"Because the light of the shechina which is to evil ones as smoke, is to the righteous ones a cloud."

wo.

So let's see here.

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Smoke.

This world.

Fog.

Unclear.

This detail alone is what separates tzaddikim and rashaim.

This is **what makes** them who they are.

Allow me to explain...

There are many things going on all the time in this world.

But it is G-d's mist.

He sees everything.

He knows everything.

He runs everything.

And we stop stumbling and panicking.

He reaches out a hand.

And we all of a sudden realize that this is His fog.

And it is carrying us in the perfect direction.

And we can sit back, and let G-d carry us.

He loves us and He runs this place.

Things are gonna work out.

This is maybe what the pasuk is hinting to when it calls Am Yisrael the "dweller within".
