This is different from the "Im about to fall" thread.this is more like im going through a very tough nisayon/time.please daven for me!


So that's the second purpose of this thread.

Ray Hirsch comments on this pasuk:

Hashem tests the righteous man's constancy and true joy in doing what is right.

If righteous living would automatically lead to immediate reward and sinfulness to immediate punishment, then selfishness - and not the exercise of free will in the performance of G-d's will - would be the motivation for man's actions. Therefore, a righteous man's sufferings are actually proof of G-d's love and interest in his moral improvement and well-being. (i.e. because He wants to perfect our hearts).
