I've heard from numerous rabbanim that the only way you repeat shemoneh esrei is if you realize IMMEDIATELY after you finish. If you only chap later- even seconds- no need to repeat.

This would have saved me countless repetitions. Including today.

I would clarify this. My understanding is that if you are unsure if you forgot, and you remember that you were planning on saying it (e.g. they klapped in shul) then you can assume you said it if your safek came later. But if your safek came during s"e then we assume you would remember if you said it.

However, if someone knows they didn't say it they must repeat s"e no matter how much later they remember.
