I'd like to make an observation please; it's somethin' that I have been workin' on lately, and it has shown results.

The observation is that in the last installment, the word "but" was used 12 times.

Experts say that one should use that word sparingly, perhaps not at all.

Why?

1. You are tryin' to control a person's judgment or perception of you.

2. You know what you truly and honestly think/want/feel, but at the same time, you are not ready to fully commit to it.

3. You are anticipatin' someone's response.

4. It can come off to someone as attackin' and immediately put them on the defensive.

5. It negates whatever precedes it.

It is important to pay attention to your use of the word 'but' because by doin' so you are contradictin' and invalidatin' everythin' that came before it. Evaluate what purpose the word 'but' is really servin' in your sentence and try to replace it with the word 'and' or 'at the same time' and perhaps some other words as well (take note of how this changes the meanin' of your sentence). Thinkin' and usin' a different word or expression creates a more effective and non-defensive conversation. By usin' 'at the same time' you channel a more collaborative feelin' with your communication.

Let's cite an example or two:

*** I don't know if you can ever understand how a man's brain works, but I want to explain my feelings to you." I couldn't believe my ears. Was he still trying to make ME UNDERSTAND HIM?!?

Let's replace:

I don't know if you can ever understand how a man's brain works, and I'd like to try explainin' my feelings to you."

She still might be upset, **and** perhaps the outrage may be decreased.

*** This made Moe angry. He knew he did something wrong, but he didn't feel that the

responsibility was 100% with him.

Now, let's say he actually said that: I know I did something wrong, but I don't feel that the responsibility is 100% with me.

Now, let's switch: I know I did something wrong, and at the same time, I feel that the responsibility is not 100% with me.

Subtle, but more mellowed.

One more:

*** I know what I did was bad, but I wanna just explain myself....

Let's switch: I know what I did was bad, and I'd like to explain myself.

Practice - you'll notice your conversations will have a different tone.
