This is a humbling thing for me. For to me it means that all those truly good Jews out there are doing many of the good things I do in recovery - *but they do it by choice*. I, on the other hand, only really ended up doing them because I **had** to (and *still* have to).

The Big Book calls it "enlightened self-interest". Not a bad thing, at all....

Humbling, and true.

I may not get a **shred** of olam habo or s'char out of this recovery. But that is fine by me. At least I will not have wasted a life by remaining the big faker I naturally am when I am not living sober.
