I give you the main informations of me to have better advices: I'm 20, french (sorry for the english), struggling since 11 years old, real ba'al techouva for 2 years, Shomer Neguia for 1 year, I'm on my first lecture of the GYE book, I read 'Hizouk every day and I study a little of 'Humach, Moussar and Tehilim every day. Since my last fall of yesterday (18 days, my best on chart) i made a "neder" with the TaPHSiC method for 1 month and I also promise to write to my brothers on forum so here I am. I want a change, from now..

Just wanted to ask you some questions about the attitude to have with the 90D Challenge because I don't understand some very important points:

- 1)The point I understand the least is to leave the battle to HKB"H. I exlain: I'm for exemple sitting in front of my desk working and I feel this desire to enter in luxury, even without internet and all this stuffs. Nothing is done but the desire is here and take more and more space. What have I got to do in this very specific moment? I tried (not well I'm sure) to speak to Hachem many times like "please Father just save me, I can't face it, give me strength, I love You and I don't want to do this" but without results. I'm sure that I've missed something to succeed with this point so I wanted your advices. I've not begin the 2nd part of the book maybe the answer is there but I also wanted advices of fighters from forum.
- 2) I have problems with facing the 2 opposite feelings in me when I'm struggling. Some days, I'm like the happiest person on the world, 100% connected with Hachem, speaking with him like a son, feeling Him above me, wanting to pray long Shmona Esré, say Brakhot with Kavana before eating etc... And after days or even hours, I'm like the totally opposite, when desire comes I'm fighting but in these moment when I need Him the most I don't feel He is with me anymore.. It make me very sad because I say to myself: "In fact you are good when you have no problems but when He send you a nisayon you can't even show your love to Him so your love is not real in fact".

I think my 2 questions are kind of related, or maybe I'm wrong. I really need help to see more clearly the situation, I'm in those periods when you have 1000 things in mind but you're not able

to analyze anything..

Thank you very much, just writting here gave me a lot of happiness, really.

This is where the center of our troubles are . It is not our eyes or the women in the street or wherever they might be (including those i look inside my head).

Learn Torah and do mitzvot that is wonderful. But what "fills you up" is giving from yourself and your self-centeredness. when the feeling of self-pity, sadness and down start to enter. that is the time to start acting by repelling them by giving to G.od and accepting his will. Hatzlacha.

Yesterday I studied Tanya and today I began Mikhtav MeEliayou and the first chapter was kind the same way of mind: both talking about the need to take moment in journey to think about the vileness of all the materials pleasure, and the elevation of a life turn to Hachem.

I just talk to Hachem "Hachem, I know all this is really really vile, how howefull lust is, taking the holiest thing of this world, the power to create a life with the perfect fusion of 2 human being,

spiritualy and physically. I know all that but I still want to do it.. What can I do..?" Then my parents came back bH..

Anw I thing I'm beginning to feel how I'm far far far from managing my life. Hachem is controlling all my life, and it's scary. I mean for 2-3 weeks now I'm trying to study really really more Torah, like 3-4 hours more per day as I'm in vacation. I study with the will to do Hachem ones, i pray i even cried yesterday and today I came back home and.... this silly desire again ..?!

I wonder how can I want to do a things I cried yesterday for i did it?

I hope all this realization about the totally control of Hachem will more boost me than other. I know He Want me to get closer to Him so I'll try to take the opportinity. I'm happy He Saved me today but I'm afraid I need these kind of miracles every single time..

As usual, I don't know if I'm clear..!

That something is usually a type of anxiety. Anything from sadness to resentments to

pain . When this happens sit and think what is it that is causing me RID :Restlessness,Irritability and Discontent. Who , what is causing you pain . Try to understand why ? are you feeling self pity , self centeredeness , selfishness ? these are causing the pain . So now move to another emotion of forgiveness and tolerance , etc.By doing this the lust should feel less to you or disappear altogether.

I know ALL THIS IS NOT TRUE, Who put me in this environment; non Jew school, vid games and lust videos since 10, drug, bitoul zman so hard..? Surely the Master, so I should be proud of myself for the way done already. I know it but I don't succeed in being proud of myself, I don't know I would always compare myself to a frum guy of bnei brak who certainly knows half of the chase at my age and even more..

As I said before bH I found the book of Rav Tauber on emouna (and as he says it's begin with knowlegde of yourself) where he is talkin about how every single jew is unique and each time I do a mitzva, it gives to Hachem a pleasure that no one as ever give to Him and more, a pleasure no one CAN give to Him.

I try to focus and this but surely, to answer your question, the most source of desire is sadness to not be where I think I have to.
