The worst of the makkos was choshech. (Excluding makas bechoros which was in a league of itself, none of the other makkos started with "makas"). Out of the first 9, the worst of the makkos was choshech. Why? There were many other makkos that had much larger loss of human and animal life!

R' Shabsi Yudilevitz said that because in the first 8 makkos they had each other. In choshech they were alone. People can tolerate a lot of things, but one thing many people cannot tolerate is being alone. So firstly, I want to thank all of my chavirim here on GYE from the bottom of my heart for being there for me at all hours of the day and making it that I don't go through this alone.
