Aside from free association, I guess my point is, I feel like I'm at a loss right now. I've lost confidence in myself and the tools available. I'm posting to the forum because I know it's what I should do.

I know intellectually that what I'm saying is wrong. That even if I fall who knows how many more times, it's more about the day to day life than the streak, the getting back up and the incremental successes. And that there is success in the 6 days I just had, and there is success in me even trying. But it's just all disappointing emotionally.
