- 2. This is just a fact. Period. If a guy keeps on fantasizing, even if he never LOOKS with his eyes at anything any more, he is doomed to continue to fall time after time. Sometimes a guy can win the battle of not looking, but this point, i.e., fantasizing, his yetzer can tell him it's muttar for years and years. Meanwhile, he wonders why he keeps falling despite nedarim and trying with all his will power to stop. The answer is simple.
