i will try to explain. In healthy attraction a person walking down the street will notice a women that is attractive to him. His mind will then quickly filter that result based on the appropriateness of the attraction. e.g. if one of them is already married then she is off limits. He will not fantasize about her because it is not an option. If indeed she is an option, then he will go about courtship in a respectful and appropriate way.

Obviously if someone is dressed very provocatively this can play with your mind, but ultimately, someone that has a healthy way of feeling and processing attraction will filter the person out because they are off limits.

someone with a distorted and unhealthy sense of attraction, will walk down the street without this filter. Everyone they see has the potential of being the object of his fantasies. Instead of thinking that the woman is attractive to me, let me see if i can find out more about her, get to know her etc in an appropriate manner, he can jump straight into sexually fantasizing about her without knowing her at all and without knowing if he would enjoy having a conversation with her.

This is posted on a very simple level. There are many steps to healthy courtship. Fantasizing about sleeping with random women you see on the street is not one of them. There may be many people that do it and think that it is normal. It is not healthy and it is not an indication of having more sex drive, It is an indication of not knowing how to properly process and filter attraction.

I am not saying this in judgement of your feelings of attraction, rather i am trying to explain the clinical difference as i understand it between healthy and unhealthy attraction.
