I wrote some may consider me a Talmud Chacham" let me state unequivocally that I do not consider myself one for I know how little torah I actually learn!!the sole reason I brought that in is for the cautionary value of that aspect of "my-story" meaning that even if a person may be considered a Torah scholar they are not immune from the wiles of the YH.
