Posted by bardichev - 31 May 2010 16:50 **KEEP ON LORRYING!** OH HERE FROM THE BBC (BIG BEN CHIMES) Lorry fire on M11 burns 17 tonnes of magazines A lorry carrying 17 tonnes of magazines has burst into flames on the M11, leading to a one-way closure of the motorway. The vehicle caught fire at about 1100 BST and was under control an hour-and-a-half on Thursday. The magazines are believed to have been destroyed. The motorway had been closed between junctions four and five into London but has now reopened. The Highways Agency said motorists should avoid the area if possible. A London Fire Brigade spokeswoman said: "It was an articulated lorry carrying paper which is believed to have caught fire. "It was approximately 17 tonnes of magazines and it was very badly damaged. "We had two fire engines and about 10 firefighters." The flames were under control by 1242 BST.

Firefighters were unable to say why the lorry had ignited but an investigation is under way.
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
