I do realize that for many people here the damage is deeper and cannot be fully undone. This has nothing to do with your strength. If you were addicted for a much longer period of time, you may never be able to see a woman without being overwhelmed by lust. Again, this has nothing to do with willpower. Hashem was kind to me and let me get out of this early, and for that I'm very thankful. But each person here must do what can be done to avoid things which are triggering. If that means never speaking with women, that is what must be done, and I have much more respect and admiration for those people who fell to that level and have still broken the addiction than I do for myself and others like me.
